They also carry diseases to the plants grown on farms. (問 27) costs farmers a lot of money. Many farmers use chemicals to keep pests away. These chemicals can be bad for the environment, though. They can kill other creatures. They can also get into the fruits and vegetables that people eat.

The owners of the Vergenoegd Low wine farm in South Africa use a different method. They want to stop pests from eating their grapes. At the same time, they do not want any chemicals to get in their wine. Their solution is to (問 28) to remove pests. Every day, a team of over 1,000 ducks is taken to the fields where the grapes are grown. The ducks spend all day walking around the plants and eating the pests.

Although ducks have been use control pests in rice fields in Asia for hundreds of years, the use of ducks in other places is much less common. The ducks used on the Vergenoegd Low wine farm are a special kind. They have (問 29) than other kinds of ducks. As a results, they cannot fly away. Using ducks to control pests also has another advantage. Their waste helps the grape plants to grow.
