For thousands of years, people have found these waters to have health benefits. They are said to help our skin and blood flow. Spas are often built near hot springs so visitors can enjoy the healthy waters.

In the phone book, he found the phone number of Bill Hewlett, one of the founders of HP, and called him. They spoke for 20 minutes. Hewlett didn't just give Steve some components for the machine for free, he also gave him a job in the HP factory. Steve was always a good talker!
